Los Angeles area chapter donates \$500 from fundraisers to Trust Women Wichita Clinic, in Kansas.

Pasadena, July 1, 2020 – The San Gabriel Valley Chapter of NOW has made a \$500 donation to the clinic founded in the memory of Dr. George Tiller, who provided later term abortion care for women from across the country and the world, and who was murdered in 2009 by an anti-abortion extremist.

NOW SGV has supported pro-choice clinics and domestic violence shelters and services since the 1970's. Its members include women from all sectors of the business and political world, in addition to the women and mothers, single, or in relationships, working inside and outside the home, who first took to the streets of Washington, DC to protest for change.

In the intervening years, NOW has seen many of its feminist ideals come to fruition, and we are working towards an even more just, fair and equal society. Current issues include supporting passage of the ERA, getting out the vote, educating young women on the need to maintain and build upon our successes, and a further embracing of intersectionality with LGBTQ and Women of Color.
